GriefShare makes it easy for your church to help people grieving the death of a friend or loved one. With GriefShare resources, you can quickly equip a lay ministry team to launch a comprehensive, Christ-centered grief recovery ministry—even if they have no prior ministry training!

They also explain how their daily GriefShare workbook exercises are helping them see their situation from God's perspective. During the discussion, group members also share the challenges they're facing and victories they're experiencing.

Each GriefShare participant receives a workbook. This workbook helps participants sort their thoughts and emotions and helps them discover what God says about their situation. Each workbook contains daily Bible studies, weekly journal sections, a gospel presentation, tear-out Scripture cards and more.
